

Updated Honor Roll Criteria for 2019-2020 School Year
Please see the highlighted areas for updated criteria.

Student Recognition: In an effort to honor students' efforts in behavior, academics, citizenship, and attendance, China Middle School recognizes students each quarter with the following achievements:

Honor Roll: Grade point average of 85-92.99 and no grade below a 70 in all classes.

High Honors: Grade point average of 93-100 and no grade below a 70 in all classes.

(2019-2020 school year: Students in grades 5- 7 receiving High Honors for Quarter 3 will receive a gold card to be used during Quarter 1 for the 2020-2021 school year.)

Dean's List: Students earn Dean's List by achieving High Honors all school year.

(2019-2020 school year: Students earn Dean's List by achieving High Honors for Quarters 1, 2 & 3 and passing all classes for Quarter 4.

Students in grades 5-7 will receive a CMS sweatshirt in the fall.

All Grade 8 students will receive a high school sweatshirt this year. Students receiving Dean's List will have their name embroidered on the sleeve.)

Dean's List Breakfast: Students who earn Dean's List will be invited to the Deans' List Breakfast with the Principal and Assistant Principal at the end of the school year.

Promotion Ceremony Recognition:

The following students will receive a white or gold cord to wear at 8th Grade Promotion:

White cord: Honor roll Quarters 1, 2 & 3 and passing all classes for Quarter 4 of eighth grade year.

Gold cord: Dean's list Quarters 1, 2 & 3 and passing all classes for Quarter 4 of eighth grade year.
